Ansätt : $u(x, y) = X(x)Y(y)$.

$$X(x)Y(y) = X(x)Y(y)$$

Dividera med $X(x)Y(y)$.

$$\frac{X(x)}{X(x)} = \frac{Y(y)}{Y(y)} = \text{konstant} = \lambda$$

$$X(x) - \lambda X(x) = 0$$

$$Y(y) - \lambda Y(y) = 0$$

$$X(x) = Ae^{\lambda x}$$

$$Y(y) = Be^{\lambda y}$$

$$u(x, y) = Ae^{\lambda x} Be^{\lambda y} = Ce^{\lambda(x+y)}$$
