1. All submissions (including papers, proposals of invited sessions) should be sent to the Secretariat of Program Committee.
2. Submissions can be done via either regular mail or email. To avoid duplicate, only one of these two ways is allowed. If you choose to submit your paper by post, two copies should be sent to the Secretariat of Program Committee.
3. The CCC presents Guan Zhao-Zhi Best Paper Award and other special awards annually. Paper submitted to CCC can simultaneously be eligible to apply for the Awards. 4. The organizer of an invited session is requested to submit a 1000 word proposal of the invited session and the detailed abstracts of all invited papers in the session to the Secretariat of Program Committee. Papers in an invited session should present a cohesive and comprehensive focus on a relative topic.
5. All accepted papers will be included in the conference CD-ROM and many also be published, with the agreement of the authors, in some Chinese core journals selected by the conference Program Committee.
